Description of the event:

The event had three main parts:

- Presentation of the project scope, objectives, results, partners
- Presentation of the results from WP2. Into SE Future for Romania
- Discussion about SocioComp framework and next steps for social economy occupational standards development for Romania

The event started with the presentation of the project – scope, partners, period, main activities and expected results. There were discussed the project's results in the context of the Romanian social economy sector and how it would contribute to the development of social economy in Romania.

The next topics addressed were related to the social economy sector in Romania, based on the results of the national report developed in WP2. Into SE Future: Social economy sector indicators (number of entities and employees in social economy organisations, percent of social economy organisations in small and medium enterprises sector, percent of employees from social economy sector in total number of employees in Romania etc), Social enterprises, Social integration enterprises and sheltered units sector (number, type of entities etc) and Competences needed in the Romanian social economy sector. To address these themes, in addition to the presentations, we conducted an activity in groups of 10 participants to find out what challenges they have in their work (social enterprises, professional integration of vulnerable groups, and so on).

Presentation about SocioComp - the social economy sector specific skills framework. The presentation included a description of the framework and main topics that will be included.

Recommendations on occupational standards for social enterprise managers and social economy entrepreneurs in Romania concluded the theoretical part of the event.





The final part of the event included facilitated discussions with the participants on the occupational standards of social enterprise manager and social economy entrepreneur in Romania and also conclusions and recommendations.











Iasi, Romania

Date and place: 24th November 2023, Iasi - ADV Romania

Number of participants: 21



The event brought together managers and support personnel from various social enterprises from Iaşi, Bucharest, Timişoara, Oradea, Satu Mare, Câmpulung, or Galaţi. After a detailed introduction of the baSE project, which included a presentation of the activities carried out and the results obtained so far, we moved on to a more interactive section of the event, dedicated to discussions about the ways in which we can update and improve the existing occupational profiles in the social economy sector.



We explored ideas about how we can make these profiles more relevant to current realities, taking into account the evolution of community needs and the market. We also discussed the importance of integrating new technologies and innovative approaches into the activities of social enterprises.





